(a) You have 3 cookies and 2 friends.

(b) You have 4 cookies and 2 friends.

(c) You have 5 cookies and 2 friends.

(d) You have 3 cookies and 3 friends.

(e) You have 4 cookies and 3 friends.

Make a conjecture about how many ways you could distribute 7 cookies to 4 people.
